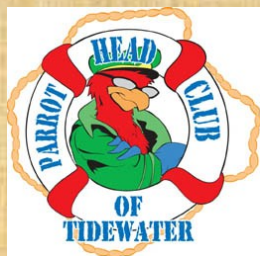

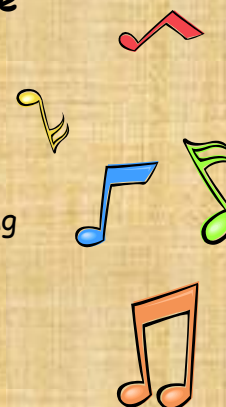
3 Corn Hole Competition will be coming back. Marc Nesseler the "Cornfather" (Godfather) of Corn Hole will be using his charm.
