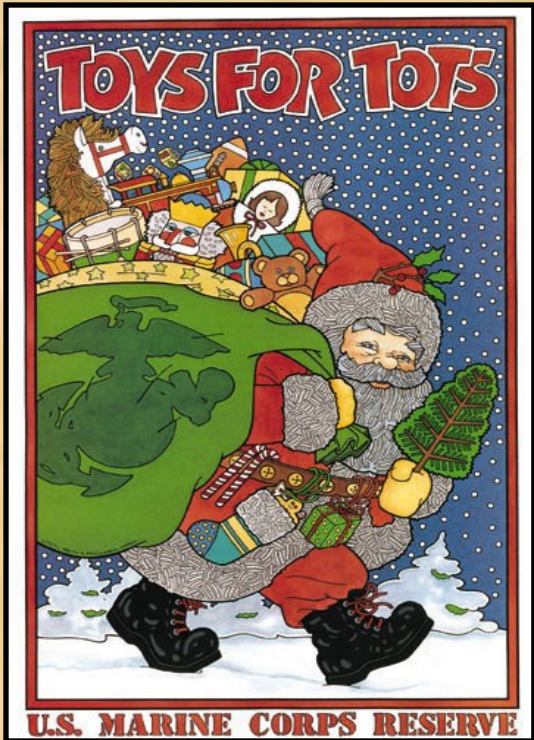

Again this year, we will be collecting non-violent, unwrapped toys at the December club meeting.

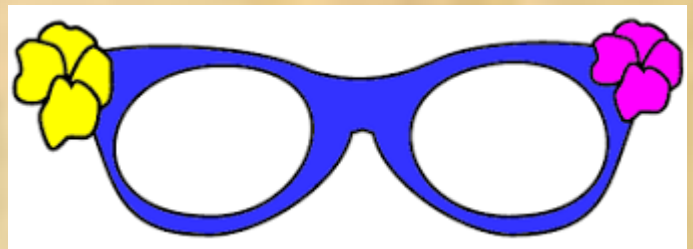
Help us make the holidays magic for some special children this season!!!
